Mrs. VE3BHQ's Famous Broccoli Salad

As you probably remember Fanny's wife, Nancy, made an awesome Broccoli salad for the Christmas party. Many people wanted the recipe and she was gracious enough to share her secret with us. Thank you Nancy!

(1 ½ recipes makes a good size for a group of people)

1 head of broccoli (maybe 2)
½ c raisins
½ c sunflower seeds
½ c slivered almonds (I use 'no name' slivered almonds)
½ c green onions (chopped)
10 slices of bacon (cooked, cooled, broken up)

Method:

Remove large stem of broccoli and cut broccoli into individual florets with shortened stems. The florets should be 'bite size' pieces. (Across the top of the floret should be approximately 3/4" - 1').

Mix all of the above items in a bowl and add the following dressing just before serving.

Dressing:

1 c mayonnaise
½ c sugar (Splenda works well also)
2 Tbsp. Vinegar
Mix together and pour over broccoli salad.
